

RESOLUTION NO. CCLXVII (267)

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CITY COUNCIL'S INTENTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF
THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Eldon E. Edwards, previously employed as the city's planner
to complete the Comprehensive Development Plan, has resigned effective
Friday, July 13, 1979, leaving much of the project yet to be completed;
now therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that:

1. The city's staff planner, Stephan A. Lashbrook, is hereby directed
to proceed immediately to assemble and review the materials submitted by
Mr. Edwards and prepare an appropriate work program for the completion of the
Comprehensive Development Plan project.

2. This work program, now authorized to be completed shall be utilized
as the basis of the city's request for proposals to screen prospective con-
sultants for the completion of the Comprehensive Development Plan.

3. Grant funds received from the State Land Conservation and Development
Commission (LCDC) shall be encumbered for the purpose of hiring a consultant
who is skilled in the preparation of plans to meet LCDC requirements.
