## RESOLUTION NO. CCLXVIII (268)

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF DOING THE WORK FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO N.E. TERRITORIAL ROAD, NORTH LOCUST STREET AND NORTH JUNIPER STREET (LID #10)

WHEREAS, the improvement of portions of N.E. Territorial Road, North Locust Street, and North Juniper Street, is required and will consist generally of curbing, basing, and paving a 10 foot strip of street on N.E. Territorial Road fronting the Clark-Overton property, and a 40 foot street on North Locust Street and North Juniper Street, south from N.E. Territorial Road to the south boundary of Crestview Addition. The improvement project will also include the extension of an 8 inch sanitary sewer main from North Maple and N.E. Territorial Road west to North Juniper Street, and south on Juniper Street to the southern boundary of Crestview Addition, and south on North Locust Street from N.E. Territorial Road to the southern boundary of Crestview Addition; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed improvement project was duly and regularly called and held before the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on June 20, 1979, after notice thereof was first given in the manner and for the time required by Ordinance No. 393, to the record owners of each lot, tract or parcel of land or portion thereof, to be specially benefited by the improvements. There were no oral objections or written remonstrances made or filed at or prior to the said hearing and after the hearing the council found that there were not sufficient remonstrances (in fact none) and decided to proceed with the improvement project; now therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED by the Common Council for the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, that the City proceed with the improvements to N.E. Territorial Road, North Locust Street and North Juniper Street according to the City Engineer's report and plan for such improvement project; and that the employment of Compass Engineering Company of Milwaukie, Oregon, as engineers to work with and under the supervision

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of the City Engineer is approved in order to prepare the detailed plans and specifications for said project; and the work of this improvement project shall be done in due course on contract, and the City Engineer is authorized and directed to advertise for bids in the Canby Herald and other usual trade publications for at least once a week for two successive weeks prior to the time scheduled for opening bids; and to open the bids as received and report the results to the Canby City Council.
