

RESOLUTION NO. CCLXXIV (274)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION OF NORTH LOCUST STREET, COUNTY ROAD NO. 2578.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County, Oregon, accepted the City's request for jurisdiction over a portion of North Locust Street, County Road No. 2578, and made its Order No. 79-2278 on November 8, 1979, transferring jurisdiction over a portion of said road as described in said Order, but on condition that the City's acceptance of jurisdiction must be made to Clackamas County Board of Commissioners within ninety (90) days from the date of such order; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council initiated this matter by its Resolution No. CCLXXI (271) which was adopted on August 29, 1979, and entitled "A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT JURISDICTION OF NORTH LOCUST STREET AND REQUESTING FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION FROM CLACKAMAS COUNTY FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS"; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council desires to complete this matter and is willing to accept jurisdiction over that portion of North Locust Street, County Road No. 2578, as described in said Order of the Board of County Commissioners; now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED that the Canby City Council hereby accepts from the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners jurisdiction over the following described road, to-wit:

That portion of North Locust Street, County Road No. 2578, located in Section 28, T3S, R1E, of the W.M., being 721.2 feet in length lying between N.E. Territorial Road and the south line of said Section 28 mentioned above, all within the City limits of Canby.
