

RESOLUTION NO. 379

A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY RECORDER
FOR THE JUNE 24, 1986, SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Canby City Charter, Chapter VI, Section 1,
prescribes in part as follows:


"In addition to any notice required to be given by State
election laws, the Recorder, pursuant to directions from the
Council, shall give at least ten (10) days' notice of each
regular City election by posting notice thereof at a
conspicuous place in the City Hall and in at least one
public place in each voting precinct of the City. The
notice shall state, at least, the officers to be elected,
the ballot title of each measure to be voted upon and the
time and place of the election.

WHEREAS, Clackamas County has elected to conduct a "mail-in"
election for the June 24, 1986 Special Election.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby will have a measure of a "One
Year Special Levy" for the 1986-87 City of Canby Operating Budget
on the June 24, 1986 ballot.


NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that inasmuch that the
June 24, 1986 City budget election will be by a "mail-in" ballot
and voting precincts will not be open, the City Recorder will not
post the notice of measure at the precincts as prescribed by the
Canby City Charter.
