

RESOLUTION NO. 383 (CCCLXXXIII)

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF CANBY NOT TO BE NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY, IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST, TO SELL, EXCHANGE OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER SAID PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby owns certain real property commonly known as 325 Northeast Second Avenue and more particularly described in "Exhibit A" attached to this resolution and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing pursuant to ORS 221.725 was held on March 19, 1986 to discuss publicly the proposed need for said property by the City; and

WHEREAS, it was determined following the public hearing, that said property is not needed for public use; now therefore it is hereby


RESOLVED that said property located at 325 Northeast Second Avenue in Canby, Oregon, more particularly described in "Exhibit A" to this resolution is not needed for public use; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Canby, by and through its Mayor, City Administrator and City Recorder are hereby authorized in the public interest to enter into negotiations to sell, exchange or otherwise transfer said real property.
