

RESOLUTION NO. 394

A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO BALLOT MEASURE NO. 5

WHEREAS, on November 4, 1986, voters will cast their ballot on Ballot Measure No. 5 which "legalizes private possession and growing of marijuana for personal use"; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs survey has revealed that Oregon students are heavier users of virtually every illegal drug than students in other parts of the country; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has demonstrated leadership by citizens, schools, and parents in drug abuse prevention which has been recognized on both state and national levels; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has shared in the community effort to confront drug abuse by outlawing the sale of drug paraphernalia and supporting community prevention programs such as Dare to Care.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the voters of Canby are urged to show their support in the effort to combat drug abuse in our community by voting "NO" on Ballot Measure No. 5.
