

RESOLUTION NO. 396

PRESCRIBING MONTHLY RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has determined that the operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer collection and treatment system must be self sustaining through collection of monthly sewer service charges, and an increase in charges is required in order to fund increased costs of operating, maintaining and repairing the City's collection and treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City's "Sewer" Ordinance No. 727, which was enacted and became effective January 1, 1983, expressly provides in Section 30 that the Council by resolution shall establish appropriate rates to be charged for monthly sewer services to be deposited in the City's sanitary sewer operating fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the rates hereinafter specified and hereby established are just, reasonable and necessary; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED that effective January 1, 1987, rates to be charged for City of Canby sanitary sewer services are as follows:

Single Family Residential	\$ 8.00
65 and Older or Handicapped (with maximum income of \$7,500 per household)	5.70
Multi-Family Residential	8.00
Mobile Home Sites	8.00
Transient Quarters	8.00 first unit plus 4.00 each additional unit

PUBLIC AND INSTITUTIONAL

Elementary School (\$0.30 per student shall be charged for each calendar month. Student enrollment shall be determined at the beginning of each quarter.) .30/student

Middle and High School (\$0.40 per student shall be charged for each calendar month from September through and including May; and the monthly charges for June, July and August shall be 25% of the previous month of May. Student enrollment shall be based on the enrollment as of the first day of October each year.) .40/student

Commercial, Retail, Office, Restaurants	**	1.00
Commercial Government	**	1.00
Car Wash, Laundry	**	1.00

**Per 100 cubic feet sewage, \$8.00 minimum		

Permission to discharge and fees for extra strength sewage shall be determined by the Public Works Department.

Cubic Feet volume for sewage will be the same as water used for the months of November through March; or an annual average, which ever is the lowest amount.

For new establishments, an estimate will be made by Public Works and used for billing, until actual water volumes are available.

Deductions will be allowed for verified quantities of water lost in evaporation processes and water retained in products.


These sewer rates as now established shall continue until changed by subsequent resolution of the Canby City Council; and the City Administrator shall notify the Canby Utility Board immediately of this rate change and thereafter.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution Nos. 283, 287 and 346.
