

RESOLUTION NO. CCCXIII (313)

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SECOND PROPERTY TAX LEVY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 18, 1982, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982-83.

RECITALS

The City's first and prior property tax levy election for fiscal year 1982-83 was called by Resolution No. CCCXI (311) adopted by the Canby City Council on March 17, 1982, and the election was duly and regularly held as authorized and scheduled and the proposition was defeated by a vote of: Yes 704; No 747. The City's budget committee has met, reviewed the matter, considered the City's cost of doing business, the times generally, and the requirements of the committee and recommended that another property tax levy election be called to be held at the next possible date and without change in the budget or the amount of the levy requiring voter approval; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that a second property tax levy election be held in and for the City of Canby on Tuesday, May 18, 1982, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M., at each of the regular polling places in and for the City of Canby for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City pursuant to LOCAL BUDGET LAW, and Article XI, Section 11, of the Oregon Constitution, the question of approving a property tax levy for that portion of the City's budget which exceeds its authorized tax base and which portion is partially State financed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election hereby called shall be conducted by and through the County Elections Office as now required by law; and that upon the conclusion of the election, the results thereof be certified by the Clackamas County Elections Department to the Canby City Council.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of the ballot for this matter and which was submitted by the Acting City Administrator to the Clackamas County Elections Department and captioned " ONE YEAR SPECIAL LEVY" ,

is hereby approved. The amount of the budget which is outside the 6% tax limitation but will be financed partially by the State of Oregon and which requires voter approval is \$656,385.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that additional notices of this election (in addition to those being published by the County Elections Department in the Canby Herald)

be given by the City Recorder as required by the Canby City Charter by posting at least ten (10) days prior to said election at each of the polling places in the City and also in three (3) other public and conspicuous places in the City.
