

RESOLUTION NO. CCCXIX (319)

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY OREGON TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION OF KNIGHTS BRIDGE ROAD.

WHEREAS, it has been considered and deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, and the residents thereof, that said City acquire jurisdiction over a certain portion of Knights Bridge Road which is a county road lying within the corporate limits of said City and a description of which is hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has indicated through its road department staff, a willingness to surrender jurisdiction over said portion of Knights Bridge Road pursuant to authority of ORS 373.270 and a formal request by Council resolution is required; now, therefore,


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, that it is necessary and/or expedient and for the best interests of the City to acquire jurisdiction over the hereinafter described portion of Knights Bridge Road which is a county road within the corporate limits of the City and used primarily and extensively by and for city residents. Said portion of said road is particularly described as follows:

That portion of Knights Bridge Road beginning at the east end of the bridge structure crossing the Molalla River, and continuing easterly along the present alignment to the most westerly point of Knights Bridge Road conveyed to the City of Canby by Clackamas County Commissioner's Order No. 16810, dated November 29, 1968, and accepted by City of Canby Resolution No. LXXVIII, dated December 16, 1968.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Canby is willing and able to accept jurisdiction of the above described road and maintain it thereafter as a city street and public thoroughfare for the benefit of all users; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be furnished forthwith to the Board of County Commissioners or authorized representatives; and that the City Superintendent of Public Works shall supervise this matter on the City's part and cooperate with the County as may be required to expedite this requested transfer of road jurisdiction.
