

RESOLUTION NO. CCCXXII (322)

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AND CALLING A CITY TAX BASE ELECTION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF CANBY, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1982, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON THE QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING A NEW TAX BASE FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, OREGON CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Canby, Oregon has determined that a new tax base should be established as authorized by Subsection 2, Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of City affairs within the limitation contained in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the 1979 Legislative Session produced a new Tax Relief Plan which requires taxing units without updated or with an inadequate tax base to ask for voter approval for a new tax base and the City of Canby is in that category and requires a new and updated tax base; now, therefore,

The Common Council of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, hereby RESOLVES that:

1) DATE OF ELECTION. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Resolution shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Resolution and the election laws of this state to the legal voters of the City of Canby, Oregon, at a special City Tax Base Election hereby called to be held in and for the City of Canby on Tuesday, November 2, 1982.

2) FORM OF PROPOSITION. At the City Tax Base Election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Canby for their approval or rejection the following proposition:

"Should a new tax base of \$1.5 million be approved for City of Canby to begin in 1983-84 fiscal year?"

3) ELECTION PART OF STATE-WIDE GENERAL ELECTION. There is a regular state-wide general election being held in the state of Oregon and in the city of Canby on Tuesday, November 2, 1982, and this City Tax Base Election is called to be held concurrently therewith and as a part thereof.

4) ELECTION TO BE CONDUCTED BY COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE. The City Tax Base Election shall be conducted by and through the Clackamas County Elections Office in each of the City's regular voting precincts as now required by the State Election Laws; and upon the conclusion of the election the results thereof shall be certified by the

County Elections Office to the Canby City Council.

5) FORM, CAPTION AND NUMBER OF THE QUESTION. The following is the form, caption and number of the question to be printed on the official ballots:

PURPOSE: This will allow a new tax base for City of Canby. The new tax base will apply the limit of taxes as in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution. Current tax base is \$168,142 and the new tax base would be \$1.5 million. It would pay for essential City services for some years.

EXPLANATION: The tax base now being used was voted in 1966. Canby has had much growth since then. Inflation has also dropped the buying power of the City's dollar. The City needs property tax moneys to operate the library, police, fire department, swim pool, streets and court.

6) NOTICE OF ELECTION. The City Recorder shall publish this referendum measure in full in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published weekly in the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, once each week for two successive weeks, the first publication to be not less than fifteen (15) days before the special election at which the proposed new City Tax Base is to be voted on and the City Recorder shall also post notices of such election in six (6) public and conspicuous places within the City and also at each polling place. The notice to be posted shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF ELECTION TO ESTABLISH A NEW TAX BASE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 2, 1982, in each of the regular voting precincts and polling places in the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, from 8:00 o'clock A.M. until 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, a City Tax Base Election will be held at which the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of the City for their approval or rejection:

Should a new tax base of \$1.5 million be approved for City of Canby to begin in 1983-84 fiscal year?

The official ballot will include below the caption of the matter the question, the purpose, and an explanation.

The election will be conducted by and through the Clackamas County Elections Office.

7. VOTERS' PAMPHLETS UNNECESSARY. The notices of the City Tax Base Election required to be given by Section 6 of this Resolution shall constitute the only notice necessary. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Canby or any official thereof or the Clackamas County Elections Office to furnish the legal voters at the City Tax Base Election pamphlets containing either: (a) the text of the proposition, or (b) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.
