

RESOLUTION NO. CCCXXVIII (328)

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FINAL PLAN AND RECOMMENDATION OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY 911 USER BOARD COMMISSION FOR A COOPERATIVE EFFORT IN A SIMILAR BUT SEPARATE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF CANBY.

RECITALS

1) The 911 emergency telephone system is a uniform emergency call number for any type of emergency. It replaces the separate numbers for police, fire and emergency medical care. The 911 call goes to a central switchboard and is automatically transferred to the right department. This speeds dispatch time and makes it easy for anyone of any age to get assistance when they need it.

2) Clackamas County has established a 911 Task Force which has completed a final plan to inaugurate this system in the county for the benefit of the rural areas and also the cities which desire to participate, and the plan authorized the Board of County Commissioners to establish a 911 User Board Commission.

3) The City of Canby is in the process of developing the same or similar 911 system for the City of Canby and its environs in cooperation with the Canby Telephone System and with minimal, if any, cost to the City.

4) The Canby City Council supports in concept the county plan, recommends the establishment of a 911 User Board Commission and offers cooperation with the county as may be requested by the county or required of the City in order to coordinate the county and city plans but without a commitment by the City at this time for any cost sharing; now therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED

1) That the Canby City Council endorses the Clackamas County 911 Task Force Final Plan and the establishment of a 911 User Board Commission; and will designate a representative to that commission;


2) That the City proceed with the establishment of its separate but similar plan in cooperation with the Canby Telephone System and advise the county of this fact by copy of this resolution and appropriate letter by the Canby City Administrator; and

3) That the Council request of the Board of County Commissioners the right to participate later in the County Plan if that is ever necessary in order to fully utilize the two systems and develop them for the greater benefit of the City and County.
