RESOLUTION NO. CCCXXX (330)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE ORDER AND OFFER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION OF KNIGHTS BRIDGE ROAD.

WHEREAS, it has been considered and deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interest of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, that said City acquire and accept jurisdiction over a portion of Knights Bridge Road which is a county road lying within the corporate limits of said City and a description of which is hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to ORS 373.270, has conducted a public hearing and has deemed it to be expedient and for the best interests of the County to surrender jurisdiction over the following described County road within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, and

WHEREAS, the Board of the County Commissioners has made an Order and offer to surrender jurisdiction over said County road to the City of Canby and which said Order and offer was made by the Board of the County Commissioners of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, on November 10, 1982; Order No. 82-2200; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, that by virtue of the foregoing and pursuant to the provisions of ORS 373.270, the City Council of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, does hereby accept jurisdiction as offered by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, over the following portion of County road being described as follows:

That portion of Knights Bridge Road beginning at the east end of the bridge structure crossing the Molalla River, and continuing easterly along the present alignment to the most westerly point of Knights Bridge Road conveyed to the City of Canby by Clackamas County Commissioner's Order No. 16810, dated November 30, 1968, and accepted by City of Canby Resolution No. LXXVIII, dated December 16, 1968.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Recorder Pro Tem of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon shall be and are authorized and directed to execute and sign on behalf of the City of Canby any further papers which may be necessary or required to accomplish the transfer of the County's jurisdiction over the above described portion of County road.
