

RESOLUTION NO. CCCXXXII (332)

A RESOLUTION CALLING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 29, 1983, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1983-84.


BE IT RESOLVED that a property tax levy election be held in and for the City of Canby on Tuesday, March 29, 1983, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M. at each of the regular polling places in and for the City of Canby for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City pursuant to LOCAL BUDGET LAW, and Article XI, Section 11, of the Oregon Constitution, the question of approving a property tax levy for that portion of the City's budget which exceeds its authorized tax base and which portion is partially state financed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election hereby called shall be conducted by and through the County Elections Office as now required by law; and that upon the conclusion of the election, the results thereof be certified by the Clackamas County Elections Department to the Canby City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of the ballot for this matter as attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" for identification purposes, is hereby approved, and the form of notice of this measure election as attached hereto marked Exhibit "B" for identification purposes, is hereby approved; and notice of this election shall be given by the City Recorder as required by the Canby City Charter by posting at least ten (10) days prior to said election at a conspicuous place in the City Hall and in at least one public place in each voting precinct of the City.
