- 6. NORTH PINE STREET 4th Avenue to Territorial Road County FAU 7009
- 7. NORTHEAST 3RD AVENUE, 4TH AVENUE Ivy Street to Highway #993 - City FAU 7012
- 8. SOUTH 1ST AVENUE Mulino Road to Highway 99E County FAU 7010
- 9. NORTH CEDAR STREET 3rd Avenue to 5th Avenue City FAU 7012
- 10. BROWN ROAD Haines Road to Highway 99E County FAU 7002; and
