

RESOLUTION NO. 416

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE CANBY UTILITY BOARD FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Canby and the Canby Utility Board, an independent governmental subdivision of the City, are presently contracting privately for separate retirement plans for their respective employees; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has been advised by the Canby Utility Board that said Board desires integration of its separate private retirement system through Safeco into the Public Employees Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges the charter authority of the Canby Utility Board to act, contract, and to be sued and sue as an independent entity; and

WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges the ability of the Canby Utility Board to contract independently with the Public Employees Retirement System for integration of its private retirement plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CANBY that it supports the request for integration of the Canby Utility Board's employees retirement plan through Safeco Insurance Company into the Oregon Public Employees Retirement System.
