

RESOLUTION NO. 435

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TRANSPORTATION PROJECT
RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE OREGON STATE TRANSPORTATION
COMMISSION

WHEREAS, a formal organization is needed in Clackamas County to review and comment on major transportation issues, plans and projects, including, but not limited to, the Oregon Department of Transportation's Six-Year Plan Update; and

WHEREAS, a Clackamas County Transportation Committee has been formed, composed of the professional staff of the cities of Clackamas County and County of Clackamas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has from time to time been concerned with coordinated development of appropriate traffic arterials to provide for the transportation needs of the residents, inhabitants and businesses; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the municipalities of Clackamas County recognize the need to coordinate their efforts through an organization established for such purpose and Clackamas County has indicated a willingness to provide the administrative assistance and personnel needed to implement such an organization, its studies and recommendations; and


WHEREAS, the first priority of the Committee is to prepare a coordinated package of City/County transportation project improvements; to recommend to the Oregon Transportation Commission.

WHEREAS, endorsement of this City/County transportation package by all cities and the County will strengthen our shared interests and positions in improving our communities' transportation network.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby, Oregon, that the project list in the attached Exhibit A be approved for submittal to the Oregon Department of Transportation for inclusion in the Six-Year Transportation Plan.

PRIORITIZED PROJECT LIST

Federal Aid Interstate (FAI-4R) Projects

A. Existing Projects (first priority)

1. I-205 & Sunnyside Road Interchange Northbound On-Ramp Widening
2. I-205/Sunnybrook Split Diamond Interchange - move forward into construction
3. i-5/Kruse Way Interchange - move forward into construction
4. I-5/Wilsonville Interchange - move forward into construction
5. Oregon City Park and Ride Lot - construct Park & Ride facility

B. New Projects (second priority)

6. I-205 Park Place - examine capacity and level of service. Identify and implement corrective measures. Motorists are experiencing severe congestion and backups on I-205 at OR Hwy 213.
7. I-205 @ Gladstone Interchange - redesign ramps and conduct P.E.
8. I-205 @ Highway 43 Interchange - redesign ramps and conduct P.E. & examine needs for auxiliary lanes.

Access Oregon (ACH)

1. I-205 - Rock Creek Jct. (Sunrise Corridor) - full right-of-way acquisition 1993 and construction.
- 1A. McLoughlin Shortfall (Sunrise Corridor) - additional funding needed for units 1, 2, 3.
2. (Sunrise Corridor) Hwy. 234 from 99E - I-205 EIS - conduct environmental impact study on transportation options including grade separated intersections to improve efficiency and traffic safety.
3. (Sunrise Corridor) Hwy. 212 Rock Creek Jct. to Hwy. 26 (including hill climbing lane) environmental work by 1992, right-of-way 1993 followed by construction.
4. Hwy. 26 - Zig Zag to Rhododendron, 1990 continue with construction plans for grading, paving, structure, and signing.
5. Hwy. 26 - Rhododendron to Timberline Hwy. grading, paving, structure, guardrail, rock fall protection.
6. Hwy. 26 - Heidi's Jct. - Madras Corridor Study (West Unit) - reconnaissance - followed by development and construction of recommended projects.

Federal Aid Primary (FAP), State Funding (STATE), State Modernization (STA MOD) Projects

A. Existing Projects (first priority)

1. Hwy. 213 Spangler Hill - Mulino Climbing Lane (STA MOD)
2. Hwy. 213 - Greentree Drive Intersection
3. Hwy. 43 at Jolie Point - Intersection improvements
4. Hwy. 43 and Pimlico - intersection improvements (HES)
5. Hwy. 43 at Walling Way - intersection improvements
6. Hwy. 211 Bear Creek - Keith Rd. - grade, paving, signing

B. New Projects

7. Hwy. 43 at Terwilliger - intersection
8. Hwy. 99E @ Arlington (P.E. - Gladstone)
9. Hwy. 99E @ South Second Street (Oregon City)
10. River Road at 99E Intersection Modification (Milwaukie)
11. Hwy. 213, Toliver Road - Hwy. 211 Left Turn Channelization
12. Hwy. 99E - three intersections in the City of Canby: Grant, Elm, Ivy - improved turning radii
