

RESOLUTION NO. 499

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING HISPANIC YOUTH AT RISK PROJECT TO A VARIETY OF YOUTH FUNDING ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, a project is needed in Clackamas County to coordinate development of appropriate initiatives to provide positive experiences for youth at risk of harmful gang influences; and

WHEREAS, a Clackamas County Hispanic Youth at Risk Committee has been formed of the professional staff of the cities, schools and County of Clackamas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has been concerned with coordinated development of appropriate intervention projects to provide for the interruption of inappropriate behavior leading to adolescent delinquency and gang related activities; and


WHEREAS, representatives of the municipalities of Clackamas County recognize the need to coordinate their efforts through an organization established for such purpose and Clackamas County Social Services Division, Hispanic Services Roundtable, the local school districts, including ESD Migrant Education and Clackamas Adolescent Intervention Services have indicated a willingness to endorse the need to implement such an organization, its studies and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the first priority of the Committee is to develop City/County/School intervention project to form a plan of intervention to enhance Hispanic youth appropriate behaviors; and


WHEREAS, endorsement of this City/Social Services School package by all cities and the County will strengthen our shared interests and positions in improving our communities' youth network relations, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Canby, Oregon endorses the "Hispanic Youth at Risk Project" County wide and support the project to be located within the City of Canby to provide services to "at risk" Hispanic youth.
