A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT BONDS FOR EXPENDITURES PAID PRIOR TO DELIVERY OF THE SEWER BONDS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that expenditures with respect to which the Issuer reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of Reimbursement Bonds are for Sewer Plant Renovation.
