RESOLUTION NO. 516

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BOUNDARY COMMISSION APPROVAL OF CREATION OF A CLACKAMAS COUNTY ENHANCED LAW ENFORCEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Blue Ribbon Report on Law Enforcement was presented in December, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 5 reemphasizes the need for efficient and effective service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff and City Police Chiefs are continuing to work toward areas of operational efficiencies.

WHEREAS, the "Fair and Efficient Law Enforcement Committee", set up and recognized by the cities of the County and the Board of County Commissioners, made recommendations to the cities and the Board of County Commissioners in its report dated October 22, 1991, including creation of a law enforcement service district in the North Clackamas urban area;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Canby recommends that the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission approve the proposal to create the "Clackamas County Enhanced Law Enforcement District" so the question may be submitted to the voters at the November 3, 1992 general election.
