

RESOLUTION NO. 525

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS FUTURES COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, police/fire/emergency communications in Clackamas County is administered through five answering points and dispatch centers; and

WHEREAS, technological advances warrant a coordinated, detailed review of communications capabilities among all users within Clackamas County; and

WHEREAS, increased communication traffic has placed demands upon the existing system which creates potential safety issues for police and fire personnel; and

WHEREAS, Clackamas County police and fire users have evidenced a desire to conduct a comprehensive review of the existing police/fire/emergency communication system in Clackamas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the cities and fire districts within Clackamas County and the Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County that we recognize a Committee to be known as the;

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS FUTURES COMMITTEE

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that the said Committee be charged with reviewing the current police/fire/emergency communication system and studying options and developing a recommendation with regard to available hardware/software technologies as well as the financing of a recommended system.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that the said Committee be charged with studying options and developing a recommendation with regard to a system of governance for the police/fire/emergency communications system in Clackamas County.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Committee shall forward its report with specific recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners, Canby City Council, all other Clackamas County City Government entities, and all Clackamas County Fire and Emergency Services agencies by January 15, 1993.

ADOPTED the 4th of November, 1992, by the Canby City Council.
