## **RESOLUTION NO. 529**

## A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF WILLOW CREEK WETLANDS

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission approval of the preliminary plat for Willow Creek #2 required protection of the defined wetlands and stream corridor and buffer strip; and

WHEREAS, such plat approval also required that the stream corridor be treated as common area and be maintained by the Subdivision Association; and

WHEREAS, the proposed wetlands boundary, the roadway construction and tennis court construction, including preservation and mitigation plan have been approved by the Division of Stated Lands and Corps of Engineers including a wetlands definition and stream crossing permit; and

WHEREAS, a proposed Final Plat has been prepared dedicating to the City of Canby, the wetlands, stream corridor, and buffer area and indicated on such proposed Plat as Tract A and B; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning and the Director of Public Works have recommended acceptance of such dedication to insure perpetual protection of such wetlands and stream corridor; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That the City of Canby City Council accepts the proposed dedication to the City of Canby of Tracts A and B of the proposed Final Plat for Willow Creek #2 and that maintenance of such tracts be provided by Willow Creek Homeowners Association by separate agreement.
