

RESOLUTION NO. 532

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City of Canby budget for the 1992-93 fiscal year was approved by the voters of said City at a Tax Base Election on November 6, 1990, and a Supplemental Budget for expenditure of unanticipated revenues was approved after a Public Hearing thereon held on March 3, 1993.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has now received unanticipated revenues and a Supplemental Budget is required for the expenditures of such funds according to ORS 294.326 (1). No further voter approval is required.
