NOTICE OF CITY MEASURE ELECTION



The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

- CAPTION (10 Words) CHARTER AMENDMENT PROHIBITING CITY FROM EXTENDING MINORITY STATUS TO HOMOSEXUALS
- QUESTION (20 Words) Shall City Charter be amended to prohibit minority or other special status for homosexuals or expending funds to promote homosexuality?
- *SUMMARY Amends City Charter, prohibits City from extending minority status based on homosexuality, sexual orientation or preference and from enforcing such laws. Prohibits City spending to promote or approve homosexuality. Does not deny City services based on lawful sexual practices. Does not limit public library materials for adults. Does not nullify civil rights based on race, religion, color, sex, marital status, familial status, national origin, age or disability. Does not limit constitutional rights. Allows laws which prohibit employment decisions based on non-work related reasons.
