

**RESOLUTION NO. 548**

**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE APPLICATION TO ODOT FOR  
ISTEA FUNDING FOR THE MOLALLA RIVER PATHWAYS  
PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the cities of Canby and Molalla along with Clackamas County are trying to create a transportation corridor between the two cities for bicycle and pedestrian traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, this corridor will connect the southern part of Clackamas County with proposed and existing bicycle and pedestrian corridors all the way to downtown Portland making alternative modes of commuting possible; and

**WHEREAS**, the Molalla Forest Road would provide a safe corridor for bicycle and pedestrian traffic because of its planned restriction to only that type of traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Molalla Forest Road was completed over fifty years ago and is a significant historic resource to the region, now therefore be it

**RESOLVED** that the Canby City Council endorses the application for ISTEA funds to the Oregon Department of Transportation and urges the selection committee to consider favorably the application.
