A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE APPLICATION TO ODOT FOR ISTEA FUNDING FOR THE MOLALLA RIVER PATHWAYS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the cities of canby and Molalla along with Clackamas County are trying to create a transportation corridor between the two cities for bicycle and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, this corridor will connect the southern part of Clackamas County with proposed and existing bicycle and pedestrian corridors all the way to downtown Portland making alternative modes of commuting possible; and

WHEREAS, the Molalla Forest Road would provide a safe corridor for bicycle and pedestrian traffic because of its planned restriction to only that type of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Molalla Forest Road was completed over fifty years ago and is a significant historic resource to the region, now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Canby City Council endorses the application for ISTEA funds to the Oregon Department of Transportation and urges the selection committee to consider favorably the application.
