OAR Chapter 125 division 20 (Personal Services Contracts, effective January, 1995).

OAR Chapter 125 division 30 (State Purchasing, effective January 1995)

OAR Chapter 125 division 300 (Public Contract Exemptions, effective January 1995)

OAR Chapter 125 division 310 (General Exemptions, effective January 1995)

OAR Chapter 125 division 320 (Public Contract Exemptions, Information Systems Contracts)

OAR Chapter 125 division 330 (Specific Exemptions)

OAR Chapter 125 division 360 (Waiver of Security Bid and Performance Bond)
