

RESOLUTION NO. 696

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON
REPEALING RESOLUTIONS NO. 337 AND 338 GOVERNING THE AWARD
OF A CABLE FRANCHISE TO CANBY TELEPHONE ASSOCIATION**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 337 was enacted on April 20, 1983, to establish rules and regulations and standards of operation for the then-proposed award of a cable franchise to Canby Telephone Association; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 338 was enacted concurrently with Resolution No. 337 to regulate rates and charges for cable service; and

WHEREAS, the franchise awarded under Resolutions No. 337 and 338 is now expiring and will be renewed pursuant to a new and distinct process governed by federal law, and Resolutions No. 337 and 338 are therefore no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will separately consider the grant of a renewed franchise to the successor in interest to Canby Telephone Association,


NOW, THEREFORE,
