EXHIBIT A

RIGHT OF WAY DESCRIPTION

A tract of land located in the Philander Lee D. L., No. 49, in the northwest one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of Section 4, Township 4 South, Range 1 East, of the Willamette Meridian described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of South Ivy Street and County Road No. 47, said point also being the North line of the Philander Lee D. L.C. No. 49; thence Southeasterly along the centerline of South Ivy Street approximately 34.41 feet; thence Northeasterly perpendicular to South Ivy Street approximately 30 feet to the Northwest corner of the tract of land conveyed to Charles K. and Mary A. Celley in Fee Number 75-27360, Clackamas County Deed Records, which point is the true beginning of this description;

Easterly along the South right-of-way of County Road No. 47 approximately 171.63 feet to the Northeast corner of the Celley tract; thence Southeasterly along the east property line of the Celley tract approximately 5.08 feet; thence Westerly and parallel to the South right-of-way of County Road No. 47 approximately 90.35 feet; thence along a 175-foot radius to the left with a delta of 9° 30' 19" and curve length of approximately 29.03 feet; thence along a 35-foot radius to the left with a delta of 93° 23' 36" and curve length of approximately 57.05 feet to the West property of the Celley tract; thence Northwesterly along the East right-of-way of South Ivy Street approximately 55.64 feet to the Northwest corner of the Celley property which is the true beginning of this description, containing a total area of 1,420.58 square feet.
