RESOLUTION NO. 621

A RESOLUTION SETTING INDUSTRIAL WASTE DISCHARGE LIMITS, DEFINING NORMAL WASTEWATER POLLUTANT CONCENTRATIONS, REQUIRING INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMITS, AND ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE TESTING OF INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council is required, by Ordinance No. 868, to establish discharge limits for pollutants that may be introduced into the municipal sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the following discharge limits have been recommended to the City Council by the Public Works Director and are in accordance with the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1251 et. seq.); and

WHEREAS, all industrial users listed as Categorical Industrial Users by CFR 40 Part 403 et. seq., or determined to be a Significant Industrial User as defined in Ordinance No. 868, are required to obtain an Industrial Wastewater Discharge Permit which will be valid for five (5) years, and

WHEREAS, all industrial users under the Industrial Pretreatment Program will be sampled and inspected bi-annually for compliance with Ordinance No. 868 and this Resolution, and will pay the costs for laboratory analysis.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Canby City Council resolves as follows:

Section 1. Established pollutants and concentrations for standard domestic wastewater, effective immediately, for pollutants, are set forth below:
