

RESOLUTION NO. 633

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT H.O.P.E. VILLAGE LOW INCOME ELDERLY
APARTMENT DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has recognized that there is a significant unmet need for quality, affordable housing for the area's low income elderly residents; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council recognizes and approves of the housing development efforts of the Housing and Outreach Project for Elderly, Inc. (H.O.P.E.) currently underway in the HOPE Village complex; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council supports the concept of providing affordable mixed income senior housing together with resident activities and services; and


WHEREAS, the Canby City Council supports elderly housing development which will allow the community's seniors to age in place; and


WHEREAS, the Canby City Council is informed that Housing and Outreach Project for Elderly, Inc. (H.O.P.E.) is currently applying for funding through the State of Oregon's Housing and Community Service Department which would allow them to provide for these unmet affordable housing needs in our community, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Canby City Council of the City of Canby wholeheartedly supports the development efforts of Housing and Outreach Project for Elderly, Inc (H.O.P.E.) And its HOPE Village project which include a fifty (50) unit elderly, low income apartment complex.
