

RESOLUTION NO 660

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY PARK AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD AND BLUE HERON RECREATION DISTRICT BOARD AS RECREATION ADVISORS TO THE COUNCIL IN SUPPORTING THE DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A NEW REGIONAL PARK LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST SECTION OF CANBY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to plan for recreation for its citizens by involving key members of the recreation community in all discussions and relying on these key members to represent the views and best interests of the community at large; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby owns land on N.W. Third Avenue west of Baker Drive which must be developed for a recreational use by 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City Park and Recreation Advisory Board and Blue Heron Recreation District Board have been meeting and working together for several months, especially regarding the update of the Parks Master Plan and a Regional Park plan for the above referenced property on N.W. Third Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Regional Park Plan meets several of the community recreation needs described in the Park Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Park and Recreation Advisory Board and Blue Heron Recreation District Board both support the proposed Regional Park Plan as the best way to meet the City's obligation to develop said property for recreation; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED that the City Council authorize the City Park and Recreation Advisory Board and Blue Heron Recreation District Board to act together for the purpose of planning, designing and implementing a Regional Park Plan on City property located on N.W. Third Avenue, west of Baker Drive, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council supports the effort to build the Regional Park and that an Intergovernmental Agreement be created to further define this partnership between the City of Canby and the Blue Heron Recreation District for the good of all Canby area citizens.
