WHEREAS, the City of Canby will benefit from this program and should therefore, encourage participation of community members in this project, now therefore, be it


RESOLVED that the Canby City Council of the City of Canby supports the community service team project for the Hispanic youth and will be a partner in the projects and needs when appropriate.
