## **RESOLUTION NO. 682** A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE BLUE HERON RECREATION DISTRICT TO SEEK A VOTE TO ESTABLISH A PERMANENT RATE LIMIT FOR OPERATING TAXES

WHEREAS, the Blue Heron Recreation District is a special district organized pursuant to State law; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Heron Recreation District is authorized to seek a "vote to establish a permanent rate limit for operating taxes" pursuant to ORS 451.547; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has previously passed Resolution 660, "a Resolution Authorizing the City Park and Recreation Advisory Board and the Blue Heron Recreation Distict Board as recreation advisory to the Council in Supporting the Design and Implementation of a New Regional Park Located in the Northwest Section of Canby"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has approved an updated Park and Recreation Master Plan (which includes the above mentioned regional park) to guide the development of new park and recreation amenities for the citizens of Canby; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Heron Recreation District, in partnership with the City and with the approval of the people, can best provide for the implementation of the City Park and Recreation Master Plan in a reasonable time frame for the benefit of all citizens of the Canby area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that it supports the efforts of the Blue Heron Recreation District to partner through an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Canby to provide area recreation services and to seek a vote to establish a permanent rate limit for operating taxes at the November election, 1998. ADOPTED this 2nd day of September, 1998, by the Canby City Council.
