

RESOLUTION NO. 795

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF PROPERTY ALONG HIGHWAY 99E LOCATED JUST WEST OF BURGerville RESTAURANT FROM THE HOLLAND, INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A PARK AND VIETNAM WAR MEMORIAL FOR THE CITY OF CANBY.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council was approached by the Canby Veteran's Memorial Committee (Committee) with a proposal to fund, build and maintain a memorial to US military veterans on Highway 99E in Canby; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has also approached The Holland, Inc., a Washington Corporation, more commonly known as Burgerville restaurant about donating a portion of its property along Highway 99E in Canby, just west of its current Burgerville location for the site of the memorial; and

WHEREAS, The Holland, Inc., has proposed to donate at no charge a portion of its property to the City of Canby to be used for public park purposes and to serve as the site of the Veterans Memorial, a copy of the legal description of the property is attached to the Dedication Deed as Exhibit "A".; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this project is would be a valuable asset to the City of Canby and therefore, whole heartily supports it ;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby, as follows:

Section 1. The Canby City Council accepts the Dedication Deed of a parcel of land located on Highway 99E just west of the Burgerville restaurant from The Holland, Inc., a Washington Corporation, to the City of Canby for the purpose of establishing a public park in honor of US military veterans.

Section 2. The Canby City Council directs the Mayor of the City of Canby to execute the Dedication Deed on behalf of the City and insure that it is properly recorded in the Deed Records of Clackamas County, Oregon.


This Resolution shall take effect June 5, 2002.
