## **RESOLUTION NO. 799**

## A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESULTS OF MAY 21, 2002 ELECTION, PROCLAIMING PASSAGE OF A FIVE YEAR LOCAL OPTION SERIAL TAX LEVY TO FUND THE CANBY SWIM CENTER

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2002, at an election, the voters of the City of Canby approved by a vote of 2699 to 1192 Measure No. 3-60 which called for a five year local option serial tax levy to fund operation of the Canby Swim Center. Clackamas County Elections Department certified the above election results as accurate on June 7, 2002;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby that the Election Results as set forth in the abstract dated June 7, 2002, are official and accepted by the Council of Canby; and it is hereby

**PROCLAIMED** by the Council of Canby that a local option serial levy for operation of the Canby Swim Center was approved and shall be in effect for five years beginning in the fiscal year 2002-2003.

This resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2002.
