RESOLUTION NO. 712

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN SERVICES TO BE DEEMED MOST LIKELY SUSCEPTIBLE TO YEAR 2000 FAILURES AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO DIRECT THE EXPENDITURE OF NECESSARY BUDGETED FUNDS TO ADDRESS SAID PROBLEMS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has a written analysis of the systems it believes most susceptible to Year 2000 failures; and

WHEREAS, the Year 2000 effects are unknown and uncertain, with expert's opinions ranging from no effect to catastrophe; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby acknowledges that in the absence of a commitment to addressing Year 2000 problems, such so-called "Y2K" failures may cause interruption of essential public services; and

WHEREAS, there are multiple existing concerns which must compete for the limited public resources available to deliver governmental services; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Canby City Council that such limited resources are best utilized, as they concern Year 2000 issues, for those matters deemed "Mission-Critical";

WHEREAS, the City of Canby's 1999-2000 budget authorizes the expenditure of necessary funds to address the Year 2000 problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Canby City Council hereby declares the following services to be deemed most likely susceptible to Year 2000 failures to be "Mission-Critical":

- 1. Public safety and fire protection services.
- 2. Electrical services
- 3. Water and sewer services
- 4. City government services.

The City of Canby delegates the discretion to determine these expenditures to the Canby City Administrator.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that although the City of Canby, clearly recognizes that the Year 2000 problems may affect other areas, in recognition of limited

public resources available, it shall be the policy of the City of Canby to address the areas determined above as in the overall best interest of the public.
