

RESOLUTION NO. 713

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY RECORDER TO PROVIDE WORKER'S COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR ALL VOLUNTEER WORKERS, INCLUDING JUVENILES PERFORMING COMMUNITY SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF CANBY AND ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY AND REPEALING RESOLUTIONS 694 AND 454.


WHEREAS, the Canby City Council wishes to protect its volunteer workers, police reserves, community service workers and elected officials with insurance protection for injuries arising out of or in the scope of their service to the City in accordance with ORS 656.031- 041; and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Juvenile Department wishes to assign Canby area juveniles ordered to perform community service to service within the City, but it does not have the funds to pay for workers compensation insurance for these juveniles,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby, as follows:


1. The City Recorder of the City of Canby is hereby authorized and directed to provide worker's compensation coverage for all volunteer workers who perform work for the City of Canby, including police reserves, elected officials and juveniles ordered to perform community service at an assumed wage of between \$100.00 and \$800.00 per month.
2. Resolutions 694 and 454 are hereby repealed.
