A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANBY REQUESTING THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO INCREASE FUNDING AND PRIORITY TO UPGRADE COUNTY ROADS WITHIN THE CITY OF CANBY TO CITY **STANDARDS**

- WHEREAS, many of the county roads within and adjacent to the City of Canby are in poor to failing condition and do not meet the city street construction or classification standards; and
- WHEREAS, the citizens of Canby through the Canby Comprehensive Plan and Canby Transportation Systems Plan have expressed their wishes and requirements to have their streets and roads meet specific city standards; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have all county roads within and adjacent to the city limits serving the Canby community upgraded to city standards; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that there are limited county and city funds to achieve the needed upgrading of county roads to city standards; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges that collaborative efforts between the county and city are mutually incumbent and appropriate, necessary and desired; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council commits and wishes the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners to commit to an open dialogue to mutually decide upon a strategy and funding plan that will work for the direct benefit of their mutual constituents; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the time is now for the county and city to develop practical and achievable policies and goals to deliver quality roads to our city and county citizens.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners is hereby respectfully requested to increase their endeavors to upgrade the county roads within and adjacent to the city to city construction and classification standards; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners are hereby requested to commit county resources and funding at a higher priority and level to the said upgrade of county roads; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners are hereby requested to commit to collaborative development of practical and achievable policies and goals to deliver quality roads to our city and county citizens.
