CITY OF CANBY RESOLUTION NO. 725

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANBY ESTABLISHING SEPTEMBER 19, 2000 AS THE DATE FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF THE CERTAIN PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE LOGGING ROAD INDUSTRIAL PARK NOT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CANBY BUT WITHIN THE CITY OF CANBY URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARY.

WHEREAS, the Canby Utility Board (CUB) has suggested to the City council that it hold a special election on September 19, 2000 for the annexation of certain properties located within the Logging Road Industrial Park not within the corporate limits of the City of Canby but within the City of Canby Urban Growth Boundary, if the City Council is desirous of keeping options open for lower wholesale electric power rates from the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA); and

WHEREAS, CUB has been advised that if it buys wholesale electric power from BPA between 2001-2006, the lowest wholesale electric power rate would apply only to areas located within CUB's service territory on September 30, 2000; and

WHEREAS, certain properties located within the Logging Road Industrial Park that are not within the corporate limits of the City of Canby and are not within the service territory of CUB and, thus, would not be eligible for the lowest wholesale electric power rates; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concludes that from a marketing standpoint, attracting industry with lower electric power rates is an incentive for private investments in the Logging Road Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that an election to determine annexation of these properties into the City of Canby is necessary and prudent: and

WHEREAS, the City Council has concluded that based on historical voter annexation results, that utilization of a special election instead of a general election regarding annexation matters does not appear to affect the annexation approval outcomes of the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby that September 19, 2000 is hereby set as the date for a special election to determine annexation into the City of Canby of certain properties located within the Logging Road Industrial Park not presently within the corporate limits of the City of Canby.
