A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CANBY TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR ACQUISITION OF THE ROAD AND THE LOT OF RECORD AT THE POINT WHERE THE MOLALLA FOREST ROAD (LOGGING ROAD) MEETS THE WILLAMETTE RIVER AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements, and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Canby has identified acquisition of the lot of record at the point where the Molalla Forest Road (Logging Road) north of Territorial Road reaches the Willamette River; and

WHEREAS, this acquisition would enable walkers and bicyclists to reach the Willamette River from the Logging Road Trail and from nearby Eco Park, preserving a natural area for public enjoyment, habitat preservation, and cultural history; and

WHEREAS, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the City of Canby be authorized to apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon State Parks Department for acquisition of the lot of record where the Molalla Forest Road meets the Willamette River as specified above.
