The property is known as Tax Lot 1601 of Tax Map 3-1E-27C. A complete legal description of the tax lot is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and a map showing the location of the tax lot is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and by this reference incorporated herein; and
