## A RESOLUTION SETTING INDUSTRIAL WASTE DISCHARGE LIMITS, DEFINING NORMAL WASTEWATER POLLUTANT CONCENTRATIONS, REQUIRING INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT FEES, AND ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE TESTING OF INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 621.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council is required, by Ordinance No. 868, to establish local discharge limits for pollutants that may be introduced into the municipal sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, the following discharge limits have been recommended to the City Council by the City Administrator and are in accordance with the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1251 et. seq.); and,

WHEREAS, all industrial users listed as Categorical Industrial Users codified by 40 CFR Chapter I, Subchapter N, Parts 405 - 471, or determined to be a Significant Industrial User as defined in Ordinance No. 868, are required to obtain an Industrial Wastewater Discharge Permit which will be valid for five (5) years; and,

WHEREAS, all Significant Industrial Users under the Industrial Pretreatment Program will be sampled and inspected biannually for compliance with Ordinance No. 868 and this Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, all costs associated with laboratory analysis and sampling in order to maintain compliance with this Resolution and Ordinance NO. 868 will be payed by the industrial user; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to repeal the local discharge limits established in 1996 by Resolution No. 621.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

## **Canby Local Discharge Limits**

Section 1. Established pollutants and concentration limits for all wastewater's, domestic/commercial and industrial are effective immediately, for the pollutants, as set forth below:

NOTE: Discharges in excess of these limits are subject to extra strength charges as noted in Section 40 of Canby Ordinance No. 868.

Section 2. The following limits are for heavy metals and other pollutants. Violations of these discharge limits are subject to enforcement actions and other penalties defined in Ordinance No. 868, and the Pretreatment Program Enforcement Response Guide:

- Section 4. Sampling and analysis fees for compliance will be passed on to the discharger on a cost basis, determined by the Canby Industrial Pretreatment Coordinator.
- Section 5. Resolution No. 621 is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 6.</u> This Resolution will be effective November 7, 2001.
