

RESOLUTION NO. 767

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CANBY AND LOCAL 350-6, AFSCME COUNCIL 75, AFL-CIO FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2004.

WHEREAS, the agreement between the City of Canby (City) and the Local 350-6, AFSCME Council 75, AFL-CIO (Union) for the period July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2001 has expired; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Union have engaged in collective bargaining for the purpose of continuing their contractual relationship; and

WHEREAS, the policy of the State of Oregon, as embodied in its public employee bargaining laws, is to encourage the public employer-employee collective bargaining process; and


WHEREAS, the City and the Union have arrived at an agreement with respect to those issues that are properly the subject of collective bargaining; now therefore

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby that the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and Union be approved. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City,
