A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY
FOUR-YEAR PUBLIC SAFETY OPERATING LOCAL OPTION
TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the need for effective, efficient and coordinated law enforcement is crucial to the people of this city and county; and

WHEREAS, The budget for Clackamas County is facing a \$10 million shortfall in the coming fiscal year 2002-2003; and


WHEREAS, the county sheriff and the city police chiefs are continuing to work toward coordinated operational efficiencies and effectiveness in law enforcement in this county; and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Community Safety Levy is designed to be used by the Sheriff's Office, Community Corrections and Juvenile Department for operations for law enforcement services, including expansion of the County Jail operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby would benefit from the Clackamas County jail in that our local officers lodge all our prisoners there; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of Canby Oregon, recommends said levy to the people of the City of Canby, and the people of Clackamas County for approval at the November 5, 2002 election.
