

RESOLUTION NO. 870

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE REHABILITATION OF ATHLETIC FIELDS AT MAPLE STREET PARK.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting application for the Local Government Grant Programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby, Oregon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has identified athletic field improvements at Maple Street Park as a high priority need in Canby, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation of Maple Street Park athletic fields with a new irrigation system and infield restoration will enhance this amenity for all Canby area youth; and

WHEREAS, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time; now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City of Canby Council that the City Parks and Recreation Director is hereby authorized to apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation department for athletic field improvements at Maple Street Park as specified above.

This resolution shall take effect on July 21, 2004.
