## **RESOLUTION NO. 879**

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CANBY TO APPLY FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR REFURBISHMENT OF THE HISTORIC LOGGING ROAD BRIDGE PORTION OF THE LOGGING ROAD AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

**WHEREAS,** the Oregon Department of Transportation is accepting applications for Transportation Enhancement Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canby desires to participate in this funding program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed bicycle and pedestrian improvements and enhancements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canby has identified refurbishment and repainting of the Logging Road bridge portion of the popular Logging Road bicycle and pedestrian path as a high priority need; and

WHEREAS, the repainting of the Logging Road bridge along with the installation of higher safety railings will preserve the historic bridge and improve pedestrian and bicycle safety, as well as preparing the bridge for the application of public art at a future date; and

**WHEREAS**, improvements to the appearance of this significant structure will also serve to strengthen the aesthetics of this gateway into Canby and beautify this portion of Highway 99E; and

**WHEREAS,** the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time; now therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City of Canby Council that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for Transportation Enhancement Funds from the Oregon Department of Transportation for refurbishment of the historic Logging Road Bridge portion of the Logging Road Trail as specified above.

This resolution shall take effect on August 18, 2004.
