

## **RESOLUTION NO. 982**

### **A RESOLUTION VERIFYING THAT THE CITY OF CANBY HAS MET THE REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE REVENUES FROM CIGARETTE, GAS AND LIQUOR TAXES.**

**WHEREAS**, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820, and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

1. Police protection
2. Fire protection
3. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
4. Sanitary sewer
5. Storm sewers
6. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
7. One or more utility services and:


**WHEREAS**, City officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:


1. Police protection
2. Street construction, maintenance and lighting
3. Sanitary sewers
4. Planning, zoning and subdivision control
5. Storm sewers

This Resolution shall take effect on June 18, 2008.
