

Ordinance No. 90.

An Ordinance regulating the use of the Public Streets, Highways, Alleys, Sidewalks and Streets, and railway crossings of Canby,

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person having charge of any Railway train, Engine, Car or Vehicle used upon, or about any railway within the corporate limits of Canby to cause or permit the same to stand upon any street or road crossing, sidewalk or sidewalk crossing, for more than ten (10) minutes consecutively at any time, so as to obstruct the same or to interfere with public use and travel.

Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive or propel any Bicycle, Tricycle, velocipede, automobile, or other vehicle on or across any public road, street or alley in Canby, at a greater speed than eight miles an hour at any time.

Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive, ride, use or propel any Carriage, Wagon, truck, sleigh, sled, bicycle, tricycle, velocipede or hand Cart, [Excepting = Childrens express wagons used for delivery purposes, such wagons not to exceed 75 lbs. in weight, and carriages for children or invalids] upon any of the sidewalks abutting on platted lots and blocks of Canby, unless on proper crossings to go into or out of a yard or lot, provided however, that the drawing, pushing or leaning of a bicycle upon any sidewalk shall be and is excepted from the provisions of this section

Sec. 4. Any person or persons violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty

of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, before the Mayor or Recorder, shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty five dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail, not less than two days, nor more than ten days.

Sec. 5. That Ordinance No. 34. of the City of Canby be and the same is hereby repealed, and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its final passage, and approval by the Mayor.
