

Ordinance No. 91.

An Ordinance Entitled: An Ordinance to Assess, Levy and Collect taxes for general Municipal purposes, upon all property, both real and personal within the corporate limits of Canby, and to make a five mill tax levy in accordance with section 33 of the City Charter,

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Whereas in accordance with section 33 of the City Charter of Canby Oregon, The Council has Power and Authority within Canby to assess, levy and collect taxes for general Municipal purposes, not to exceed one-half of one per. centum upon all property both Real and personal, and whereas, the City Council of Canby deems it necessary to provide funds for general municipal purposes, be it resolved as follows:

Sec. 2. That there be and hereby is levied a five-mill tax upon all real and personal within the corporate limits of Canby for general municipal purposes, and and that the same be placed on the Clackamas County tax roll for collection as by law required.

Sec. 3. In as much as there are no funds available from any other source for general municipal purposes, and as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the public health, peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.

The foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read first time at a special meeting of the City Council held on the 22^d day of Nov, 1909, and was ordered posted, to come up

for final passage at a regular meeting
of the City Council, to be held on Wednesday
December 8th 1909.
