

Ordinance No. 97 - 104

Ordinance for opening of "C" Street, Canby, Ore
 Canby does ordain as follows:

That "C" Street be continued as herein after described: Beginning with the most North-westerly corner corner of Block No. 4 of Dedman's Addition to Canby, Oregon, running thence North 27° West 264 ft. to the South-easterly line of the Oregon & California Rail Road right-of-way, thence South 63° West tracking said line 80 feet, thence South 27° East and at right angles to said line 264 feet to the North West Corner of Block Three of Dedman's Addition to Canby, Oregon, thence North 63° East 80 feet to the point of beginning and containing .48 acres more or less, situate in Section 33 Tp. 3 South Range 1 East Willamette Meridian, Clackamas County, Oregon. The above described land to become a part of "C" Street.

This the foregoing ordinance was read for the first time ^{in the regular} March 6th, 1911 ¹⁹¹² approved and ordered posted.
